## EARL PARK COMMUNITY LIONS CLUB SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. Applicants residing in the Earl Park Lions area will receive first consideration. This includes York and Richland townships in the Benton and Newton County school district.
2. The \$1000.00 scholarships will be awarded to a graduating senior who is planning postsecondary education. This may be in pursuit of a 1 year, 2 year, or 4 year, college, trade or vocational studies program.
3. If the scholarship is not awarded to a graduating senior, then to:
  - The renewal of previous award.
  - A student presently in a studies program
  - A student returning to a studies program after dropping out for financial need.
4. Scholarship may be awarded for any of the following reasons:
  - Academic achievement.
  - Financial need.
  - Civic and high school activities.
  - Encouragement of post-secondary activities
5. Scholarships may be initiated by the following:
  - A current Earl Park Lions member.
  - An applying student.
  - A high school counselor
6. Applicant needs 2 Earl Park Lions Club member's signatures as sponsors. A list of members has been included within this document.
7. Applicant needs no prior association with members of the Earl Park Lions Club.
8. Other scholarship awards will have no bearing on selection of this scholarship.
9. Scholarship selection will be by a committee of Earl Park Lion Club members. Their decision will be final.
10. Scholarship winner or winners will be announced at their respective school's award night. The recipients will be presented a check made out to themselves and their school of choice at a future Earl Park Lions Club meeting.
11. In the event the winner does not enroll in school for the coming fall or spring semester, the check shall be returned to the Earl Park Lions Club.
